VALUE TIPS

Just spray directly onto brake components to remove grease, oil, brake dust, and other contaminants. Focus on rotors, calipers, drums, and pads. Allow the cleaner to penetrate for a few seconds, then wipe off with a clean cloth or let it air dry—most formulas evaporate quickly without leaving residue.

For best results, clean one wheel assembly at a time. Start from the top of the brake system and work downward to avoid recontamination. Use short bursts to control overspray and prevent waste.

Always work in a well-ventilated area and wear gloves and eye protection. Try to clean brakes before installing new pads or rotors. A clean surface ensures optimal braking performance and reduces noise or vibration.

VALUE TIPS

Foaming Aerosol Spray

Just spray on and wipe off with a cloth to remove fingerprints, dust, dirt, smoke film, and other common soils. Start at the top of the window or mirror and clean downwards to avoid dripping and streaks. Clean in a zig-zag "Z" pattern as you work your way down. Use a dry cloth to go over the surface after cleaning to ensure a streak-free shine.

While cleaning glass surfaces with paper towels can be convenient, they often can leave lint, residue, or streaks. Instead, use a cloth rag (an old t-shirt), chamois, or microfiber cloth and/or a squeegee to leave your windows and mirrors crystal clear.

Try to clean your windows on a cloudy day. Window panes warmed by the sun can dry too quickly and potentially leave streaks on the glass.
